Fostering Community in Churchill Meadows

Purpose:

To create a deeper sense of community within Churchill Meadows.

Vision:

To support activity based groups (Connection Groups) which fostering community relationships within Churchill Meadows

Connection Group Guidelines:

Must be for the purpose of fostering community

Must be for the benefit of the Churchill Meadows residents

Must be open to anyone in Churchill Meadows who meets the particular interest of the group

Must meet on a consistent basis (Weekly, Bi-weekly, Monthly)

Must meet in a public location within or close to Churchill Meadows

Must have an approved leader who meets Neighbourhood Connections guidelines

Could be for a season *or* could run with an end date in sight

Should be provided at no cost or a low cost for those participating (Any cost must be for the purpose of covering expenses and not for profit)

Connection Group Leader Guidelines:

Must initially meet with the designated CMRA leader(s) overseeing Neighbourhood Connections and sign agreement form

Must either be 18 years of age or older or be co-leading with someone who is 18 years of age or older

Must show a vested interest in building the Churchill Meadows community

Must keep the Connection Group inline with the purpose and vision for Neighbourhood Connection

Must give brief but regular updates to the designated CMRA leader(s) about how the Connection group is meeting its purpose
